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***NEW* SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY** **of the Six Nations Ambassadors Program [1 Page]**

It is the intention of the Six Nations Ambassadors Program to create an environment of empowerment, sisterhood, fun, and safety for all participants. Parents/Guardians of contestants, please go through this document with your child.

USE SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS INTENTIONALLY. As a contestant and/or Six Nations Ambassador titleholder, social media can be a megaphone for positive impact. It is a powerful tool to amplify your advocacy and connect with our community. However, every post, comment, and like can reflect directly on our program, the Six Nations Agricultural Society, and you. Share your journey, celebrate sisterhood, and engage with friends, classmates, family, and followers respectfully.

ALWAYS DOUBLE-CHECK YOUR CONTENT BEFORE PUBLISHING. Your digital footprint is public and permanent; screenshots last forever. Make sure your posts and direct messages showcase your leadership, grace, and substance. Ask yourself *"Am I proud of this post? Will I be in 6 months?"* before you publish. Threatening, intimidating, or targeting others online or in-person can carry severe legal penalties. Sending repeated, unwanted messages or digital tracking constitutes criminal harassment in Canada. The Six Nations Ambassadors Program and Six Nations Agricultural Society do not condone this behaviour in any form, by either contestants or their parents/guardians.

REGULATION OF SOCIAL MEDIA FOR MINOR CHILDREN - In Ontario, there are no specific laws governing the legal age limit for social media, but most social media platforms including Snapchat, Facebook & Instagram impose a minimum age for account creation, and there are related Federal & Provincial privacy, data protection and consent laws abided by these platforms that involve the consent of parents. **The minimum age for all of these platforms is thirteen.** Platform users under 13 are already in violation of the platform's terms of service. While the Six Nations Ambassadors program will not impose on a parent/guardian to allow or not allow their child to use social media, we'd like to gently remind parents that it is very important that conversations are had with your child(ren) to reasonably supervise their behaviour when a parent/guardian is not present, including behaviour in an online setting.

YOUR SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY. SPEAK UP – The Six Nations Ambassadors program takes all reports in a confidential manner. We advocate for our contestants and titleholders and address all reports of bullying or threatening behaviour (online or in-person) in a way that prioritizes your safety.

AS A SIX NATIONS AMBASSADOR, YOU ARE IN THE PUBLIC EYE, BOTH IN-PERSON AND ONLINE.

As per your signed contestant agreement: *"bullying, harmful or unbecoming behaviour by either a contestant, winner, or their parent/guardian, both in-person & online, can lead to disqualification, and if necessary a report will be made to the Six Nations police."*
